Competition only for advanced belts, 3 kyu – Dan, (brown belt + black belt)

KATA INDIVIDUAL

KIDS (9 – 11 years): Boys / Girls

CHILDRENS (12 – 13 years): Boys / Girls

CADETS (14 – 15 years): Boys / Girls

JUNIORS (16 – 17 years): Boys / Girls

YOUTHS (18 – 20 years): Male / Female

SENIORS (21 – 39 years): Male / Female

VETERANS (over 40 years): Male – Veterans can also participate in Seniors events

Kata rules for the group 3 Kyu – Dan: By point system.(elimination rounds and final rounds)

The competitors of each category will compete in the first elimination round down to 16 competitors (two competitors at the same time (AKA / SHIRO))

On the second elimination round the competitors will compete from 16 competitors down to the final 8 competitors (two competitors at the same time (AKA / SHIRO))

Children, Cadets, Juniors, Youths, Seniors and Veterans groups will perform in the first and second elimination rounds Sentei kata: **Bassai Dai, Enpi, Jion.** (referee choice) and in the final 8, they can perform Tokui kata (free choice), for the final places

The only categories that will compete from 8 to the final 4 will be Seniors.

In case of a draw, they must perform a different kata than in the previous rounds.

Limit of participation : 6 competitors per country per category

KATA TEAM

(kata team can include 5 kyu / 4 kyu, but must include at least one advanced grade (3kyu - Dan))

CADETS (11 – 15 years): Kata team boys / Kata team girls / Kata team mixed

JUNIORS (16 – 20 years): Kata team male / Kata team female / Kata team mixed

(Cadets can participate in extra age group: **Juniors Team Kata**)

SENIORS over 21 years: Kata team male / Kata team female / Kata team mixed

(Juniors can participate in extra age group: **Seniors Team Kata**)

Kata team rules: By point system

In Preliminary rounds: Free kata (Tokui) In the Final Round (4 Teams): different Kata than in the preliminary rounds. In the case of a draw, they must perform a different kata than performed in any other round.

Limit of participation : 3 teams per country are accepted in each category.

KUMITE INDIVIDUAL

NOTE : ALL competitors will be responsible for providing a RED obi and a WHITE obi for their use during the competition. Seiken gloves (White), tooth guards are mandatory. Groin protectors for males are optional. Breast protectors for females are mandatory.

KIDS 9 – 11 years

YOUTHS 18 – 20 years

Male – 62 Kg / Male – 70 Kg / Male – 75 Kg / Male + 75 Kg

Female - 55 Kg / Female - 60 Kg / Female + 60 Kg

SENIORS over 21 years

Male - 67 Kg / Male – 75 Kg / Male – 85 Kg / Male + 85 Kg

Female - 55 Kg / Female - 60 Kg / Female + 60 Kg

VETERANS (over 40 years): Male – 75 Kg / Male + 75 Kg

Male All Open (seniors and youths), **over 18 years old**

Female All Open (seniors and youths), **over 18 years old**

For kumite individual and team events there will two 3rd place).

For all age groups the competition is run on Ippon Shobu (2 wazari or 1 Ippon), the time for each match: 1 minute and 30 second for children, cadet and juniors.

Youths, seniors and veterans will be 2 minutes.

Limit of participation : 6 competitors per country are accepted in each ind. kumite category

If there are not enough competitors in one category they will compete in the next higher weight (kg) category. Please send the exactly weight (kg) of each participant.

KUMITE TEAM

(the kumite team can include 5 / 4 kyu, but must include at least 3 advanced grades (brown or black belt) out of a 5 person team or 2 advanced grades out of a 3 person team)

CADETS 12 – 15 years

Boys – 55 Kg (3 + 1 reserve) / Boys + 55 Kg (3 +1 reserve) / Girls Open (3 + 1 reserve) /

Mixed Open (5(3 boys + 2 girls) + 2 reserve) one match: 1 minute and 30 seconds for cadets

JUNIORS 16 – 20 years (Cadets can participate in extra age group: Juniors Kumite Team)

Male Open (3 + 1 reserve) / Female Open (3 + 1 reserve) / Mixed Open (5 (3 boys + 2 girls) + 2 reserve) : one match: 1 minute and 30 seconds for juniors

SENIORS over 21 years (Juniors can participate in extra age group: Seniors Kumite Team)

Male Open (5 + 2 reserve) / Female Open (3 + 1 reserve) / Mixed Open (5(3 boys + 2 girls) + 2 reserve) : one match: 2 minutes for seniors

For all the kumite team events, the competition is run on Ippon Shobu (2 wazari or 1 Ippon)

Limit of participation : 3 teams per country are accepted in each team kumite category.

CADETS 14 – 15 years: Boys 9 – 7 Kyu, Boys 6 – 4 Kyu, Girls 9 – 7 Kyu, Girls 6 – 4 Kyu

JUNIORS 16 – 17 years: Boys 9 – 7 Kyu, Boys 6 – 4 Kyu, Girls 9 – 7 Kyu, Girls 6 – 4 Kyu

SENIORS over 18 years: Boys 9 – 7 Kyu, Boys 6 – 4 Kyu, Girls 9 – 7 Kyu, Girls 6 – 4 Kyu

Kata rules : By point system Only one preliminary round, with kata chosen by the referee.

Two competitors at the same time (AKA / SHIRO) the best 8 scoring competitors pass to the final round. Final round (by point system) – Free (Tokui) kata,

Elimination Kata for the group 9 – 7 kyu between Taikyoko Shodan and Heian Shodan

Tokui Kata for group 9 – 7 kyu between Taikyoko Shodan and Heian Sandan

Elimination Kata for group 6 – 4 kyu between Heian Shodan and Heian Nidan

Tokui Kata for group 6 – 4 kyu between Heian Shodan and Heian Godan +Tekki Shodan (No other kata are allowed)

In the case of a draw they must perform a different kata (except 9 – 7 kyu group)

No limit of participation.

KIDS 9 – 11 years

Boys - 30 Kg / Boys - 35 Kg / Boys – 40 kg / Boys + 40 kg

Girls – 40 Kg / Girls + 40 Kg

CHILDRENS 12 – 13 years

Boys - 40 Kg / Boys - 45 Kg / Boys - 53 Kg / Boys + 53 kg

Girls – 45 Kg / Girls + 45 Kg

CADETS 14 – 15 years

Boys - 60 Kg / Boys + 60 Kg

Girls – 50 Kg /Girls + 50 Kg

JUNIORS 16 – 17 years

Boys – 68 kg / Boys + 68 Kg

Girls: Open

SENIORS over 18 years

Male – 75 Kg / Male + 75 Kg
